

**Jessie Ann Mollison  
1862 - 1945**

Jessie Ann was the sixth child of William Mollison and Margaret Whyte and my great grandmother. We know from the census of 1881\* that she was a pupil teacher; her daughter Jessie had a photo of her mother with her class. This photo would have been taken before her marriage to William Mutch in 1889. We have recently discovered from the archives in Cove Library that she was a teacher at Cove school where she and William lived from about 1889 to 1899/1900. We know from the Nigg School Board report that Miss Jessie Ann Mollison of 139 Skene Street was appointed on 14 October 1884. Or was she at Cove from 1881-6? So the photo we have may be the school in Cove. Jessie Ann and William may have met in Cove where she was a teacher and he was a lay preacher or they may have met because they both lived in Skene Street or they may have met at church in Aberdeen.



June was left at the age of 6 with her grandmother (and aunts and uncles) at 81 Duthie Terrace when her parents returned to Malaya with Lesley in 1934. She was very fond of Jessie Ann.
