John Mutch 1892-1941



Nobody is in touch with John's family and there are just two photographs of him. June met him in about 1938 when he visited Aberdeen but she did not know him well so presumably his visits to the family were rare. From various official sources and online we know that he attended Aberdeen Central School * and Aberdeen University from 1911-14 graduating in 1919*. He was a Scoutmaster. He joined up at the outbreak of war serving in the Gordon Highlanders and Royal Engineers. He received the Military Cross.*

He was a senior assistant master at Osborne House School in 1919 and then an education officer in the RAF from 1922.* He was promoted to Squadron Leader in 1939.* He married Margret Maude Marie Tebbutt (Madge) in 1920 and had two daughters one of whom is believed to be Peggy whose husband was Bernard and their son was Allen John. They lived at `Westbury', Western Road, Tring, Herts.*

He died at 48 of natural causes at Aultmore Hospital in Aberdeenshire on 3 May 1941.

Squadron Leader JOHN MUTCH (M.A. 1919), whose death occurred in hospital while he was serving with the R.A.F., was forty-eight years of age. He was the second son of the late Mr. William Mutch, printer, Aberdeen, and of Mrs. Mutch, 81 Duthic Terrace, Aberdeen. He was an Arts student at the University on the outbreak of the last war and interrupted his course to serve in the Gordon Highlanders. Later he was transferred to the Royal Engineers, and was awarded the M.C. On demobilization he continued his studies and graduated M.A. in 1919. Later he worked in the Air Ministry and was attached to the educational staff of the R.A.F. In September, 1939, he was promoted Squadron Leader. In his early days at Aberdeen John Mutch was prominent in the Scout movement and was for a time Scoutmaster of the 9th Aberdeen Troop. He is survived by his wife and two daughters, who live at Tring, Hertfordshire. Mutch, John
